

## Free School Meals/Pupil Premium Eligibility

*NB: Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, and is therefore receiving Universal Infant Free School Meals, they may still be eligible for income-related Free School Meals (and therefore additional Pupil Premium funding).*

Your child may be eligible for income-related Free School Meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Child Tax Credit (not Working Tax Credit), with an annual income below £16,190
- Pension Guarantee Credit
- Employment and Support Allowance, income related
- Support under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act, 1999
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit, with a household income of £7,400 or less (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

If you think you may be eligible, or are unsure but would like the school to check, please complete the attached form and send it back to the school office in a sealed envelope, marked for the attention of the Pupil Administrator – FSM.

You are not obliged to provide this information. This information will be submitted to LGfI (via their online checking service) so that it can be checked for eligibility of Free School Meals/Pupil Premium.
